TRAIN YOUR OWN SERVICE DOG (20 lessons)	Service dog public access obedience and service task training.	3895	Private lessons with Michael Burkey, Dogtra E-Collar & lessons in public places (stores, parks, airport, buses, etc.) If you complete early then the unused private lessons turn into Perfect Practice lessons.

PER CALENDAR DAY	Lots of love & socialization via play groups, walks, treadmill, etc.	55	
GROUP CLASSES	Taught by a MDT Trainer. Puppies and dogs must be people and dog friendly.		
PUP 1 MANNERS (ages 9-14 weeks)	\$137 for a four week class, held monthly. Puppy socialization & play time, puppy raising tips, eye attention, sit, come, down, walk on a leash, no jumping, etc.		
PUP 2 MANNERS (ages 15-20 weeks). Test for AKC Puppy Star medal	\$137 for a four week class, held monthly. Puppy socialization & play time, heel on a loose leash, stay and enhanced obedience reliability amongst distractions, etc. Graduates can continue onto the Intermediate Manners class.		
BASIC MANNERS (ages 21 weeks and older)	\$157 for a four week class, held monthly. Eye attention, sit, down, come, heel on a loose leash, no jumping, sit at doorways, etc.		
INTERMEDIATE MANNERS (test for AKC Canine Good Citizen Title)	\$157 for a four week class, held monthly. Place command which is helpful for front door greetings, return to heel position, approach other dog teams and sit politely, heel amongst distractions, leave it, etc.		
ADVANCED MANNERS (test for AKC Advanced Canine Good Citizen & Urban Canine Good Citizen titles)	\$157 for a four week class, held quarterly based on interest. Cap the drive (stop chasing something and go into a down stay), maintain a down stay 3' from other dogs for 30 seconds, heel amongst a crowd, switch heeling sides from left to right and back again, etc. The ACGC is given on the third night of class and the Urban CGC is given on the last night of class.

E-COLLAR TRAINING (ages 20 weeks and older, provided your dog knows basic commands)	\$795 for an six week class which includes a Dogtra E-Collar, initial in person ECollar fitting with a MDT Trainer, personal access to the instructor Michael Burkey (group classes online and in-person, and question/answers via a private FaceBook group) and pre-recorded videos for a hybrid of learning (online and in-person). For the first two weeks you will attend by zoom which gives you time to teach your dog to heel and come with the E-Collar without distractions of other dogs before joining the additional four weeks in-person with the other dog teams. Your class sessions will start following your initial collar fitting.

VACCINATIONS	Puppies must have had their second set of puppy shots and a negative fecal check to participate in group classes. Dogs must be current with Distemper, Parvo, Lepto, Canine Influenza and Rabies vaccinations AND within the last six months - Bordetella and negative fecal check to participate in services. Please email your puppy or dog's vaccination records to us at info@MichiganDogTraining.com
